

WORSHIP LEADER

Purpose of the Position:

To assist the minister(s) in the planning and leadership of worship services.

Responsibilities:

- Attend training and regular meetings of Worship Team (see time requirements, below).
- Work with the preaching minister in researching and planning the services no more than once every other month.
- Serve as Worship Leader on the assigned weekends for both Sunday services. This typically includes helping co-lead parts of the service as assigned and often also includes a 2-3 minute reflection on the theme for the service.

Qualifications:

Worship Leaders should be members or pledging friends of the Fellowship with at least two years of experience of attending worship at the Fellowship. Worship leaders will be effective public speakers and will have a passion for spiritual exploration and learning. They should have a commitment to excellent worship and be open to constructive feedback.

Amount of Time Required:

- Meet with the preaching minister in advance of the service (approximately 1-2 hours).
- Co-lead all worship services assigned; arrive at least 45 minutes prior to the start of the service (4.5 hours).
- Attend every-other-month meetings of Worship Leaders (2-3 hours).
- Possible special trainings would include: sermon writing; liturgy & music; poems & prayers, etc. (to be scheduled).

Length of Commitment:

One year, with the possibility of renewing for an additional year. After term ends, can re-apply to serve as a Worship Leader after a time off of two or more years.

Training and Support Provided by:

The minister(s).
