Position Description

Purpose of the Position:

Support the facilitation of spiritual expression through visual art. All committee members will support the creation, recruitment, and facilitation of art, supported and guided by the Art Committee Chair. The Art Committee is responsible primarily for the hanging of themed art shows in the Fellowship Hall, putting up holiday decorations, and working with the ministers to facilitate the creation of visual art hangings in the sanctuary or other pieces to support the service themes.

Primary Responsibilities

Facilitate the hanging of 2 themed art shows a year in the Fellowship Hall.

- Work with the senior minister to pick a suitable theme.
- Choose a date for artwork to be picked up and dropped off.
- Choose a date for artwork to be hung.

Worship Visual Arts – monthly rotation

- Work with the worship arts committee and ministers to decide on visual themes to accompany the Sunday service focus areas.
- Facilitate the creation of visual art to hang in the sanctuary and/or elsewhere to support Sunday service themes.
- Remove visual art at the end of the month. Work with Phyllis to determine if art should be relocated to another part of the building.

Organize the holiday decorations – Late November/ Early December

Qualifications

The desire to help facilitate spiritual expression through the visual arts.

Artistic or creative experience and an eye towards aesthetics.

Chair: Leadership skill and good communication ability.

Amount of Time Required

3-4 hours during the months the shows are hung, as well as for holiday decorating. 1-4 hours per month for worship arts.

Length of Commitment

Our hope and expectation is that committee members will make a one year commitment, with the possibility of renewal. Committee chair is expected to make a two-year commitment, with the possibility of renewal.

Training and Support Provided

The past committee chair will meet with the new chair for training and staff will be available for support on a regular basis.
