

JOURNEY GROUP FACILITATOR (JGF)

Position Description and Application

Purpose of the Position:

To facilitate a Journey Group (JG). Journey Groups are groups of 6-10 people (including facilitators) that meet monthly to explore spiritual themes.

Responsibilities:

- Attend annual JG training
- Attend and facilitate a monthly JG
- Keep staff and lay leadership informed of significant challenges and developments in the JGs, including pastorally relevant information about participants

Qualifications:

JG Facilitators will be good listeners and gentle leaders who are knowledgeable about small group process. They will be reliable with excellent follow through skills.

Amount of Time Required:

Monthly tasks include: 1.5-2 hours attending the JG they co-facilitate, and up to 1 hour prep time (connecting with new participants, sending meeting reminders, etc). JGF will be expected (along with all JG participants) to engage in the spiritual exercises included in the monthly curriculum and to wrestle with the questions included in the curriculum.

Length of Commitment:

One year, with the possibility of renewal.
