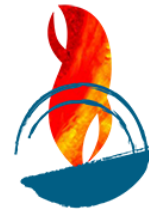
Care and Support

If you have little ones (ages 6 months to 4 years) they are welcome to stay in our supervised nursery any Sunday. Older kids are welcome to sit in the sanctuary with family. Wiggles and noises are welcome in service, as long as they aren't preventing people from hearing or seeing what's going on. We want children to feel comfortable here! Religious Exploration (Sunday School aka RE) is offered for children ages 4K-5th grade and kids are released to RE after the Wonder Box.
